## Fire Safety Refresher

Effective fire prevention is everyone's responsibility. However, not all fires can be prevented. Accidents, disasters and severe weather conditions with lightning strikes can cause fires too.

**The emergency and disaster plan outlines specific employee responsibilities and should include the following:**

1. Procedures for evacuation.
2. The assisted living's response to serious illness or accidents.
3. Procedures to follow when a resident is missing.
4. The assisted living's preparation and response to severe weather including tornado and flooding.
5. A route to dry land when the assisted living is located in a flood plain.
6. The location of an emergency shelter for the residents.
7. A means of transporting residents to the emergency shelter.
8. The procedure for providing meals to residents at the emergency shelter.
