## Fire Safety Refresher

Effective fire prevention is everyone's responsibility. However, not all fires can be prevented. Accidents, disasters and severe weather conditions with lightning strikes can cause fires too.

The emergency and disaster plan outlines specific employee responsibilities and should include the following:

- 1. Procedures for evacuation.
- 2. The assisted living's response to serious illness or accidents.
- 3. Procedures to follow when a resident is missing.
- 4. The assisted living's preparation and response to severe weather including tornado and flooding.
- 5. A route to dry land when the assisted living is located in a flood plain.
- 6. The location of an emergency shelter for the residents.
- 7. A means of transporting residents to the emergency shelter.
- 8. The procedure for providing meals to residents at the emergency shelter.
